Eligibility

1. Graduating High School Senior
2. Officiated for the NCSA during all or part of the last 4 years (minimum completed assignments of 30 games total)
3. Intends to complete academic career at a 2 or 4-year college or other post High School education

Application Process

Submit all requirements (1-3) below via email to ncsaadmin@ncsanj.com with your name and Ken Hoffman Memorial Scholarship Application in the subject line by no later than June 12, 2024

Requirements

1. Officiating Resume to include basic information
 - a. Use form below or include same info plus Post High School education plans
 - b. Officiating career – NCSA (list time span and advancement in assignments; we have all specific assignments which do not need to be listed)
 - c. Extracurricular activities, in and out of School – i.e., Community Service
 - d. Additional information that separates Applicant from other Applicants
2. Letter of Recommendation from a coach, referee or NCSA board member or assignor
3. Essay--250 to 500 words “How has my NCSA officiating experience impacted my life and shaped me as a person, on and off the field?”
4. No family relationship with any member of the NCSA Scholarship Committee
5. No family relationship with any current NCSA Board Member

NCSA Scholarship Committee (4 members)

1. Membership may consist of: NCSA Board Members, 2 NCSA Club Presidents (volunteers)
2. Self-imposed Point System determined by Committee
3. Notify recipient by June 19, 2024
